#### **Coming Together as a Community**

This month as fall arrives we have two compelling opportunities to bring the community together for the first time since the pandemic.

#### Block Party 10/29:

The Board and a group of dedicated and hard working volunteers have been doing an incredible job mobilizing and planning our community Block Party on October 29th. Please see our ad above and reach out for volunteer opportunities.

#### Getty Event 10/16:

In addition our Getty Liaison, Renee Weitzer, has exciting news with the Getty opening their doors to their Malibu & Palisades neighbors for an exclusive showing of NUBIA: Jewels of Ancient Sudan. Please see the above ad and RSVP by October 10th. These are two incredible events that were brought together through the leadership of those in the community and help to push forward the boards goals of re-establishing community bonds.

On other fronts – the board continues to thoughtfully execute against our stated goals. This month we approved a pilot program with Flock to install a camera in a highly strategic location in the neighborhood. We will assess its effectiveness and decide at a later date whether to expand the initiative, continue as is or cancel.

In the coming months we will launch a formal project with the goal of strengthening the Association's long term financial viability and bolstering our ability to continue defending the community's covenants, conditions and restrictions. We took the first step as part of the By-Law language clarification approved as part of the 2022 election. The next phase will be a clear and thoughtful approach to dues and membership. This will not be a linear path but is founded in a fundamental belief that we as a membership need to do more to strengthen our Association so that we can re-invest in productive enhancements for the Sunset Mesa community while defending it from the continued threat of overdevelopment, environmental perils and crime.

I look forward to your participation and your patience as we roll this out. See you on October 29th!

That said, a **gentle reminder that dues are not optional for membership benefits** in the Association including Block Party benefits and Architecture Committee support.





## Where are the Doggie Bags?

One benefit provided by the SMPOA is a supply of pet waste bags. These bags and dispenser stations are funded from our dues and are intended to help keep the neighborhood beautiful. The locations of the dispensers have been updated recently to try to more evenly cover the neighborhood. We previously had an over abundance of stations in the center of the neighborhood (near the corner of Wakecrest and Castlerock) but few on the perimeter. This was addressed in the spring of 2022 by relocating one station to the intersection of W Clifftop way and Castlerock. We also had a lack of stations in the western part of the community. This has been solved by adding a new station at the corner of Wakecrest and S Malibu Vista Drive. Please make use of these bags to collect your solid pet waste and dispose of it in YOUR OWN garbage. We consume about 1300 bags a month. That is a lot of waste being picked up.
