As expected with our changing climate, fire season is upon us and worse than ever before. A recent random car chase sparked a small brush fire behind and below us in Topanga Canyon last week. The SMPOA Board has been suggesting every month the need for us to actively engage in the Be Red Cross Ready Certification Programs online. Our Emergency Preparedness Committee NEEDS volunteers to institute the safety programs needed under the recommendation of local resident and safety expert, Grant Graves. With volunteers from every street, we can make Sunset Mesa as safe as we can from disasters. Please spend some time to attend the online certification program at Be Red Cross Ready, to keep yourself, your family, your street, and the entire neighborhood organized for a coherent response to all emergencies we are projected to

experience. We need your help now! Also as expected, the small group of RV and car dwellers has returned to mostly the ocean side of PCH due to a lack of consistent enforcement by CHP. Their external generators and outside cooking pose a significant fire danger to us. A small group of residents have complained to the County Supervisor Shella Kuehl's office, who have thrown it back to CHP dispatch (323-259-3200) and Officer Ramstead, who is charge of this division. They are tired from hearing of the same 2-3 people who lodge nightly complaints about enforcing the mandated and posted parking restrictions. We need all of you to pick up the phone and complain also about the lack of enforcement, including nightly fireworks and limited beach access due to dangerous permanent parking near sensitive brush and disrespectful garbage and trash accumulation.
